To book, cancel, or confirm an appointment, please use one of the options below:

1. eConsult Service

Our eConsult service allows you to complete an online consultation form for non-urgent medical concerns. This form helps our team understand your symptoms and direct you to the right type of appointment or advice.

- Visit our website and click on the **eConsult** link.
- Fill out the form with your symptoms and personal details.
- Our clinicians will review your information and respond by the next working day.

2. NHS App

Download the **NHS App** to manage your healthcare on the go. Through the NHS App, you can:

- Book and cancel appointments.
- Order repeat prescriptions.
- View medical records.
- Access NHS-approved health advice and resources.

The NHS App is free to download on both iOS and Android devices. For help setting up the app, please contact our reception team.

3. Phone System for Appointment Management

Using our phone system, you can easily manage your appointments. Simply call our main number on **0208-530-4108** and follow the automated prompts to:

- **Confirm an Appointment:** Select option [#] to confirm the time of an upcoming appointment.
- **Cancel an Appointment:** Select option [#] if you need to cancel an appointment. Please give at least 24 hours' notice to allow another patient to take the slot.

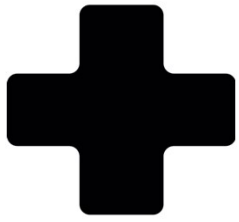


Services we offer
